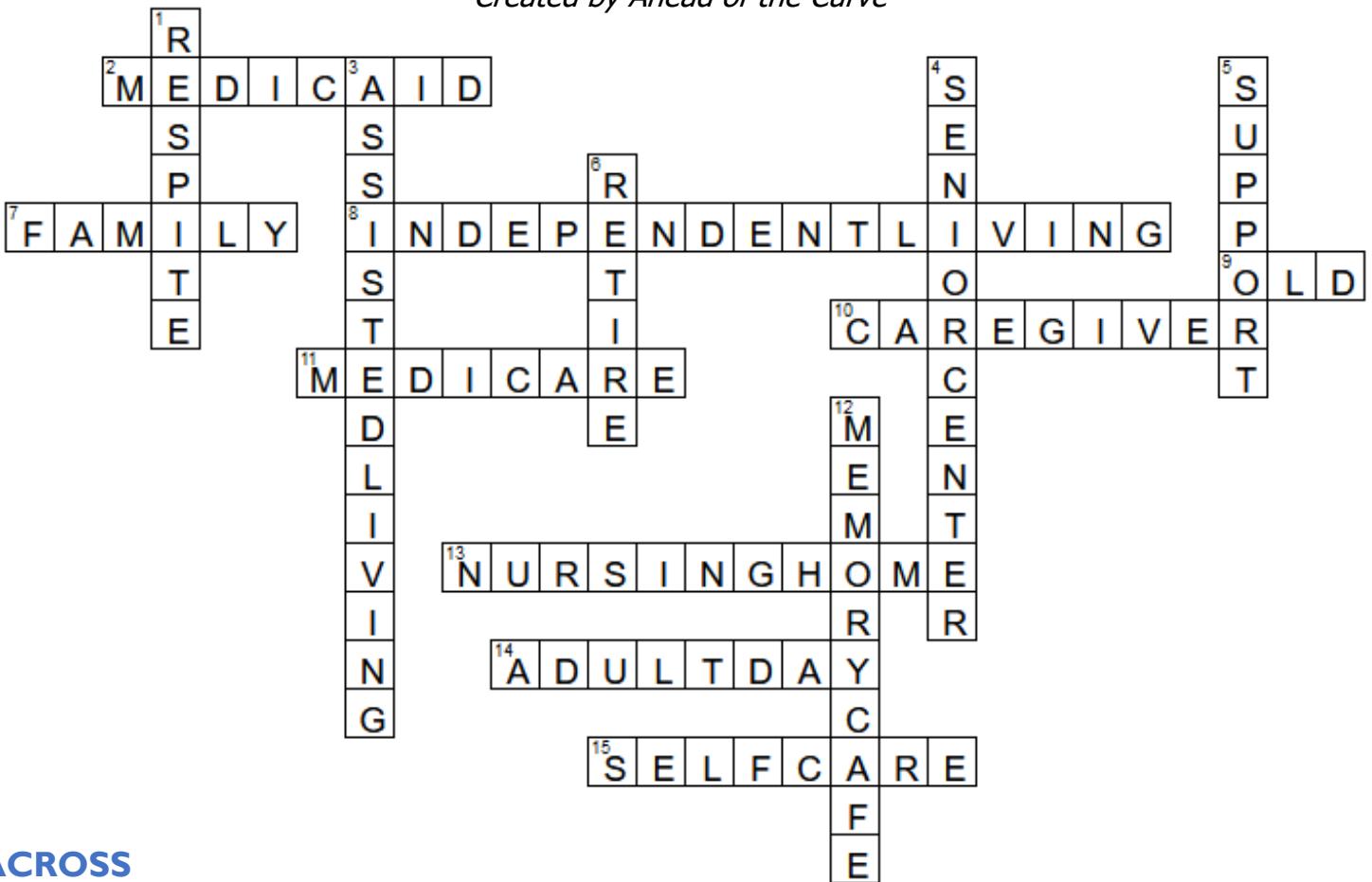


Caring Crossword

ACROSS

- 2 The federal/state funded health and long-term care program for people with limited income and assets
- 7 A group of people related to one another by blood or marriage
- 8 A residence that offers a few services as part of the basic rate
- 9 Have lived a long time
- 10 Anyone who provides unpaid assistance to another person who is ill, disabled, or needs help with daily activities
- 11 A federal health insurance program for people age 65 and over, and for some younger persons with disabilities
- 13 A nursing facility that provides immediate care, often a transition from hospital to home
- 14 Centers that help to older adults who need supervision during the day
- 15 The practice of taking action to preserve or improve one's own health

DOWN

- 1 A temporary break from providing care for a loved one
- 3 Housing for people who may need help living independently but don't need skilled nursing care
- 4 A place where seniors can be active, enjoy various social activities and improve their overall quality of life
- 5 Give assistance or help
- 6 Leaving a job and stop working, usually around age 65
- 12 A place where individuals with dementia and their caregivers can socialize, provide mutual support and exchange information
