

WASHTENAW COUNTY OFFICE OF COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

The Washtenaw County Office of Community & Economic Development (OCED) Housing Rehabilitation Program can help eligible Washtenaw County homeowners with

home improvements including:

- Emergency Furnace Replacements
- Emergency Water Heater Replacements
- Roof Replacements
- Accessibility Ramp Installations

How Does The Program Work?

If an applicant is found eligible for the program, their project is assigned to an OCED-approved, licensed contractor. OCED staff monitors all work and ensures that it is done correctly and within program guidelines.

What Does It Cost?

Many home repairs through this program are free for the applicant. Some projects will result in a 0% interest loan in the form of a lien placed on the property. With this lien, no payments are required until time of sale or a change in ownership.

Who Is Eligible For The Program?

Homeowners must reside within one of the Urban County jurisdictions **and** the household income must be lower than the income limits shown below.

Eligibility based on family size & household income:

- 1- \$52,850 annually
- 5- \$81,550 annually 6- \$87,600 annually
- 2- \$60,400 annually 3- \$67,950 annually
 - 7- \$93,650 annually
- 4- \$75,500 annually
- 8- \$99,700 annually
